

“Visitation of the Missionary Image of Our Lady of Guadalupe”

The Missionary Image of Our Lady of Guadalupe is a 4’ x 6’ exact digital replica of the original Miraculous Image left on St. Juan Diego’s cloak. The Rector of the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe, Msgr. Diego Monroy Ponce, blessed the Image for the mission of promoting sanctity of the family, solidarity of the Church in America, a culture of life and a civilization of love. It will be shown for public veneration with liturgical (or devotional) services in our parish as follows:

- Saturday, February 16th: 4:00 to 7:00 p.m. (Mass at 5:30 p.m. and confession at 4:30 p.m)
- Sunday, February 17th: before and after all Masses (8:00, 9:30, 11:30 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.).

All are welcome. Baskets for petitions and donations (checks payable to “The Missionary Image”) will be available during all visitation times.
